#### GOAL 1

Produce graduates with general education and technical skills needed to be successful in the workplace or subsequent education

Enrollment Report: Spring 11 Headcount 552 (Spring '10: 609); FTE 335.1 (Spring '10: 320.5) Graduation Report: Will have ~ 40 graduates. Special guest speaker has been identified and confirmed.

Cohorts: Will follow the model from the Kentucky system to implement with the AutoTech program (practical application of the general education components is an issue with this student body).

#### GOAL 2

<u>Provide Workforce Development programs that meet the demands of West Virginia's employers and enhance West Virginia's economic development efforts</u>

Governor's State of State Address: Macys Call Center training opportunity being explored Branding and strategies: have been working on this for a couple months – looking into ways of capturing WF learners – Sid Valentine plans to assist in identifying this count late spring.

#### GOAL 3

<u>Provide access to affordable, comprehensive community college and technical college education</u> in all regions of West Virginia

Tuition and textbooks: many schools identifying 'readers' for digital textbooks – Eastern will explore this option and other options to reduce costs of textbooks for our students.
