The West Virginia Legislature voted and adopted the West Virginia Invests Initiative for West Virginians during the 2019 legislative session.

West Virginia Invests is a state-funded grant program that covers the full cost of tuition and fees for <u>select certificate and associate degree programs</u> at a <u>West Virginia public two- or four-year institution</u>. Priority is given to programs in <u>high-demand fields</u>, such as information technology or healthcare, as determined by the West Virginia Department of Commerce. This is a last-dollar -in program, meaning that it will pay for any amount up to the total cost of tuition and fees that isn't already covered by other state or federal grants or scholarships.

The Harold K. Michael Founders Award has been established in honor of the individual whose vision led to the creation of Eastern WV Community & Technical College. Delegate Harold K. Michael, Chairman of the House Finance Committee, was studying a map of the colleges in West Virginia and saw a "gap in educational opportunities in this part of the state." As a result, Eastern WV Community & Technical College was established by the enactment of House Bill 3019 on March 21, 1999. The first award was presented to the Honorable Harold K. Michael in 2003.
