FINANCIAL AID GUIDANCE & FALL REGISTRATION AVAILABLE NOW AT EASTERN

Moorefield, WV — Aug. 6, 2010 —Open registration for fall semester, 2010 continues through August 13 at Eastern WV Community & Technical College's Moorefield center off Corridor H, about two miles east of Route 220. During regular working hours (Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm, and Tuesday and Thursday, 8:00 am - 8:00 pm), students can register for all of Eastern's traditional classroom courses, as well as all Eastern-originated online and real-time video classes.

All classes start August 16, and for a small late fee, the college will continue to accept registrations through August 20.

"If they haven't already done so, now is the time for students to call or visit the college and set up an appointment with counselors for information and guidance on financial aid, admission, registration and course selection," said Monica Snyder, Associate Director of Admissions.

"We meet our students on their terms, each as an individual with her or his own learning goals and needs. So what they bring to the appointment and tell us," she emphasized, "goes a long way in determining how we might best advise them."

The college requires all new students to attend a college orientation and take a self-paced placement evaluation. "That evaluation gives our admissions and academic advisors valuable input for designing with the student the right balance

and level of classes best suited to his or her background," Snyder said.

Through its financial aid office, Eastern also works closely and confidentially with every student who requests assistance. "And the majority of our regularly enrolled and eligible students receive some form of financial aid funding," noted Amanda Sites, the college's Director of Financial Aid Services, "whether it be grants, scholarships, loans, or outside payments."
