

Pre-Nursing Information Sheet

Nursing Program information for the **2018-2020 COHORT**

—Application distribution begins in Fall, by November 2017

—Applications and Supporting Documentation is due before February 1, 2018 at 4:30 pm –
Late submissions will not be accepted and are not considered for the program

—Students must achieve a “C” grade or above in all courses in order to progress through the program

Selection is based on a Point System and does not include an interview. The following pre-requisites are advised to prepare for entry into the nursing program:

1. English Composition I
2. English Composition II
3. Human Anatomy and Physiology I (lecture)
4. Human Anatomy and Physiology II (lecture)
5. Nutrition
6. Lifespan Psychology or General Psychology
7. Medical Terminology

Applicants must meet the following Academic requirements:

Admissions Requirements:

1. High School Diploma or US GED/TASC test
2. 2.5 GPA or higher from either high school or college courses
3. Program HESI A2 results — minimum individual composite score of a 75 or higher
4. Eligible to enter college level Math and English

Ways to prove you are at a college level in Math and English:

- a. An enhanced ACT score from the past 5 years of 18 or above in the English section or an ACCUPLACER score of 88 or above on the Sentence Skills test.
- b. An enhanced ACT score from the past 5 years of 17 or above in the reading section or an ACCUPLACER score of 79 or above on the Reading Comprehension test.
- c. An enhanced ACT score from the past 5 years of 19 or above in the mathematics section or an ACCUPLACER score of 85 or above on the Arithmetic test and a score of 84 or above on the Elementary Algebra test.

Applicants who have already achieved a successful score on the HESI A2 in the previous 3 years do not have to repeat the exam and must have official documentation of the score available for the director. A non-refundable exam fee of approx. \$60.00 is required for testing registration. The exam is administered at the college.
