TITLE:	DEVELOPMENTAL COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS AND SKILL SETS
DEFINITION:	The Developmental Course Requirements for Certificate Programs and Skill Sets Regulation defines the requirements and process for students to complete a minimum level of competency in mathematics and language arts. This regulation assures that students achieve basic computational and literacy skills.
EFFECTIVE DAT	TE: FALL, 2011
This regulation requires students to complete or test out of Developmental Reading and Math as appropriate for skill sets or certificate programs as denoted below.	
Implementation Criteria:	
The minimum level of developmental coursework to be completed for students to be awarded their first skill set is to achieve credit for either RDG 90 Reading/Study Skills OR MTH 90 Basic Mathematics.	
The minimum level of developmental coursework to be completed for students to be awarded their second skill set is to achieve credit for either RDG 90 Reading/Study Skills OR MTH 90 Basic Mathematics, whichever one is not already completed.	
The minimum level of developmental coursework to be completed for a student to be awarded a Program Certificate is to achieve credit for a College Level English course AND MTH 90 Basic Mathematics.	
Program Directors will implement these courses into program scheduling, as needed, for compliance with this regulation.
