- 1. Debi Layton and I attended the WIC recruiting event at Brighton Park on August 31st. Several agencies attended including CHIP and the Wellness Center, unfortunately the event experienced poor attendance, it was suggested that perhaps more aggressive advertising is necessary.
- 2. This fall, the first Grow Your Own (GYO) teacher initiative course EDE 1306 Introduction to Education and the Classroom courses was scheduled for East Hardy, Hampshire, Moorefield and Petersburg High School students. The program's objective is for completion of a year of college while in high school reducing obtainment of a Bachelor's degree from three to four.

A comprehensive syllabus was developed by the state with a listing of the expected Learning Outcomes derived from the course's MCRF, this syllabus may not be altered by anyone other than the state. Instruction of the course will occur online through Canvas simultaneously.

- 3. Workforce (WF) proposed and received approval from the LOT committee for amendment of welding training for transference of academic awarding credit courses to WF contact hours. Typically, WF students seek specific skills and enroll in only one or two appropriate courses, instead of pursing educational advancement or a skill set.
- 4. Logitech Rally traditional streaming systems were installed in rooms 104-B, 204, 206, 209 and 211 with video capability and the L system (mobile units) are available in rooms 205 and 208, and were designed for smaller areas; and these remote systems benefit the high school arena for enrichment of Dual students was discussed. A class facilitator is required during distant learning module courses.
